

**T**he sylynge of yro / of copper /  
of cynns / of lede / of latton / of  
goode / & of siluer / of eche lyke moche:  
all these shynge shall be layd a daye  
and at nyghte / in warme wryne of a  
chylde that is yet a mayde / thā a day  
and at night in white wryne / thā laye  
it a day & a nyght in the iuce of fenel  
than a day and a nyght in the wryte  
of a egge / than lay it a day & a nyght  
in womans mylke / that sucketh a man  
chylde / than a day & a nyght in rede  
wryne. Thā a day and a nyght in the  
wryte of .vii. egges / Than myre all  
these substances that the sayde sylyn  
gys haue layd in cogdet / and put it  
in to the bessell that ye wylly distille  
in / and do that with faste fyre. And  
the same that cometh out of your styl  
latoyr ye shall kepe in a spinet vessel  
for this water deneth and heleth al

manner of lepp / natual & conuictional  
and it purifieth all vndrennes of the  
body as bath be wel purifid / but I shal  
not nat all the vertues of this water  
for he that knoweth al his vertues doth

oseche an handful. These herbes shal  
be stamped all to gydet in a morter &  
than putte it in a clene vessell and do  
yett to a pynte of Rose water/ and a

close & let it stande so. iii. or. viii. dayes  
whan ye haue so done putte al this to  
gydet in a stylatorpe and dystyll wa  
ter of the same/ than take your dystyl  
led water and put it vpon the herbes

If ytt cloures/ a cynamom/ of eche  
an halfe ounce/ Dryous an ounce/ &  
a fewe maces/ nutmeggs halfe an ou

di/ ambers/ and some put camphet in  
it/ bytawise the materials be so hote/  
Stee all the same well togydet and  
dystille it clene of tyll it come fat lyke

let it be wel kepte. After that make a  
stronge fyre and dystill oyle of it and  
puttre it in a fyole/ this oyle smelleth

der. And it is good for olde folke and  
for them that haue taken colde.


